\* Volunteers are asked to teach for the school year or at least a minimum of a semester (Sept.-Dec. or Jan.-May). Children's learning and comfort level are enhanced with consistent and prepared teachers. The role of "Shepherd" is a KEY RELATIONSHIP BUILDER! A shepherd travels with a group of children weekly to their workshop, providing continuity. It is the shepherd who knows the children by name. The shepherd is not responsible for teaching, but will take attendance, "check in" with the children each week, be an extra pair of hands in the classroom, distribute and collect name tags, and help in ways that the teacher asks.
