PRIMARY OBJECTIVE:

Support vibrant, multi-denominational worship in a broad spectrum of musical genres and styles with high quality solo music and collaborative accompaniment.

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

Vibrant Worship Music

- Provide worshipful, professional organ/piano music for all regular, seasonal, and special services
- Support regular ensemble and choir rehearsals with high-quality, encouraging accompaniment
- Select music appropriate for themes and seasons in collaboration with the Music Ministry Director and team
- Contribute support and growth opportunities to the Music Ministry team's efforts
- Provide the Music Ministry Director regular updates detailing the current condition of the organ and piano(s) and specifying necessary maintenance

Ancillary Responsibilities

- Serve as the primary organist/pianist for weddings and funerals
- Be active in the life of the congregation and support staff efforts when possible
- Participate in all relevant planning meetings

MISCELLANEOUS:

Characteristics

- Relationally mature person with a passion for contributing to a team who provides high-quality, diverse, vibrant music
- Acts and communicates in a manner that facilitates authentic and mutually accountable relationships with co-workers, members of the congregation, and leadership
- Dependable, organized, and administratively competent
- Possesses strong musical performance skills in multiple musical genres (e.g., choral, praise, jazz, spiritual, gospel, traditional, contemporary)
- Exceptional sight-reading skills
- Proficient in open score reading
- Comfort/flexibility with improvisation, lead-sheets, etc.

Support & Accountability

- Supervised and supported by the Music Ministry Director
- Receives at minimum annual reviews from MMD
- Is accountable to the Governing Board through the Personnel Committee
- Ongoing professional development is supported and expected

This is a semi-flexible, part-time, exempt position. Weekly rehearsals and Sundays are required.
